Minutes of the meeting held on 7th April 2015 – noted.

Preliminary Ecological Appraisal - noted a report from Surrey Wildlife Trust

Land Appraisal: received a draft land valuation of Peaslake Farm from Clarke Gammon Wellers – noted; final report, including appendices, to be circulated.

Peaslake Farm: Options Appraisal

- Environmental Impact/Implications (question 3) and Community/Amenity Impact (question 4) to receive an analysis of Working Group members' comments noted B Harrap suggested that there should be a further option, for a day care centre for adults and was asked to forward the relevant information to the Clerk.
 - Borough Planning Considerations and Permissions for each option (question 2) to consider a list of questions that need to be asked of Guildford Borough Council planners – noted the draft list and that further points could be added, as necessary
 - To note a further option from the PPG for a community based mixed agricultural and business development see item on 'presentation on alternative approach below'.

Alternative concept plans - D Roe suggested that there should be an alternative concept plan that limited any housing (or housing and business) development strictly to the farm yard – agenda item for next meeting.

Presentation on alternative approach

G Reffoe and local chartered surveyor and farmer, Tim Netson gave a presentation to the Working Group on an alternative option for commercial and agricultural use of the land, comprising a combination of modular small office, workshop and retail units.
