





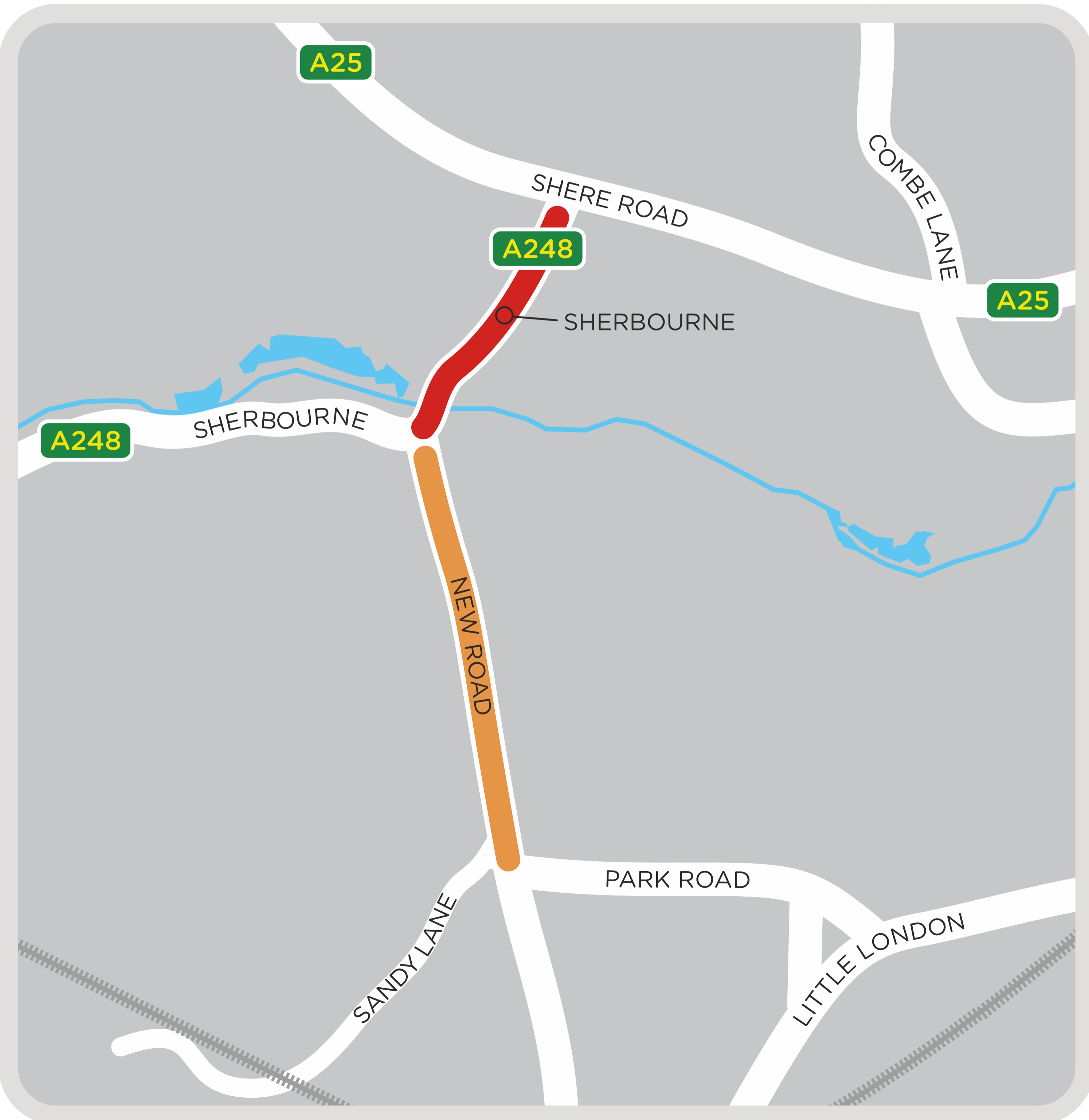


# Where is the work taking place?

We are sorry about any inconvenience our work causes and would like to thank road users for their patience. This is a complex engineering project, however we always aim to minimise disruption whenever possible.

Following consultation with the local community, we have revised our original plans and will carry out our work as follows:

### Phase one - approximately five weeks

From Monday 18 June we'll need to temporarily close Sherbourne for approximately three weeks between its junctions with the A25 Shere Road and New Road. A signed diversion will be in place for through traffic. When it is safe to do so, we will open the road using temporary traffic lights to ensure everyone's safety. We'll manually control our lights at peak times to keep the traffic flowing.

We'll also make a connection to the existing gas main in Shere Road at the junction with Sherbourne. This work will not affect traffic in the area.

### Phase two - approximately six weeks

From Monday 23 July, we'll start work in New Road. We will begin our work using temporary traffic lights. To ensure everyone's safety, we'll need to temporarily close New Road from Monday 30 July for up to four weeks between its junctions with Sherbourne and Park Road. A signed diversion will be in place for through traffic. We will reopen the road using temporary traffic lights when it is safe to do so and we'll manually control our lights at peak times to keep the traffic flowing.

We will temporarily suspend our work, remove our traffic lights and reopen the roads during the Albury Music Festival and Ride London in late July.
