Peaslake Farm Affordable Housing – Greenoak Housing Association will be submitting the plans to Guildford Borough Council for four 2 bed houses and four 1 bed houses on Peaslake Farm farmyard, by mid-March 2019. It is hoped that the houses will be built by autumn 2020. If you are interested in renting one of these new homes, please go to the Shere Parish Council website and download, complete and return an Expression of Interest Form, which you will find right at the bottom of the Peaslake Farm page <https://shereparishcouncil.gov.uk/peaslake-farm/>

Please remember to check your eligibility and be aware that you must be registered on the Guildford Borough Council Housing List to be considered for one of these homes.

The Peaslake Farm Steering Group confirmed to Greenoak Housing Association that prior to the planning application being submitted, the Council would consider the formal removal of a clause established at the Council meeting on 2nd June 2016. The clause stated 'By the time the building starts the water and sewage problems would be solved'. This formal consideration will be on the 5th March 2019 agenda and follows on from the reports and conclusions drawn, from meetings and correspondence with Thames Water, as reported at the Council meeting in October 2018.

Parish Council Contracts - Every three years the Parish Council invites tenders for Shere Parish Council contracts. The contracts are for cleaning at Tanyard Hall, cleaning/caretaker at the Old Fire Station public conveniences, Parish Maintenance – routine and Parish Maintenance – grass cutting and larger projects.
