**Local Elections** – the two vacancies on the Parish Council, due to insufficient nominations for the local Parish election, have now been filled. The Council was lucky to have three very suitable candidates for the two vacancies and after a vote by signed ballot at the Annual Council Meeting, Alex Case was co-opted onto the Council for North Ward, Shere and Gomshall and Marion Taylor-Cotter was co-opted onto the Council for South West Ward, Peaslake.

Alex has lived in Shere with his wife and three children for three years. He has extensive experience of working in senior civil service and consultancy roles and has also volunteered as a school governor at two local schools. Alex will be a great asset to the Council representing younger working families and parents. Marion, was born in Peaslake and has lived there for the past 25 years. Formally a councillor, she has returned to once again represent the interests of Peaslake residents and the wider Parish.

The Chairman, office and whole Council welcomes our new councillors.

**Election of Chairman and Vice-Chairman** – Roy Davey and Chris Carlisle were re-appointed as Chairman and Vice-Chairman respectively, of the Parish Council, for a further year.

**Shere Open Gardens disabled car parking** – Shere Parish Council has agreed to set aside a quarter of the Shere Recreation car park for disabled parking for the event this year. This will be managed by the parking attendants as visitors enter the village.

**More filming for Shere** – Shere Parish Council has agreed to filming for a Sky One original comedy about parenthood, called 'Breeders'. The filming will be taking place on the 4<sup>th</sup> June at the bridge, Middle Street, the lychgate and then in the Church.

**Peaslake Play Area – the horse has lost his head!** The little bouncy horse is sadly missing its head. The Parish Council is currently looking to replace the whole unit, so hopefully there will be something new soon.
