**Tanyard Hall Car Park, Gomshall** – Please watch out for the new parking restrictions. The car park is for users of the hall only or with the Council's permission.

**Traffic Cones** – The Council has bought 20 new traffic cones with 'no waiting' highlighted on the sleeve. Some of these cones will be placed outside the Old Fire Station toilets in Shere, in order to improve the flow of traffic across the bridge, however they are often moved by members of the public. These cones provide a purpose beneficial to the community and the council would please ask that people do not move them.

**Traffic Wardens** – Please be reminded that traffic wardens are visiting Shere and the surrounding villages more often, so please be vigilant and avoid parking illegally.

**Holmbury St Mary Traffic** – The Council is currently looking at ways to stop cars speeding through the village and will put suggestions to Surrey County Council Highways in the next few weeks. Meanwhile, the Council is hoping to install some 'gateway' signs at both ends of the village, highlighting to drivers that they are entering Holmbury St Mary village and asking them to please drive slowly through the village.
