1 Only letting one person at a time into the shop

This is for our Post Office customers only. Please let the staff know and they will let you in.

2 Serving shop customers through the hatch

If you need things we suggest you hand in a shopping list at the hatch and either wait whilst the staff pick your things or you come back at an agreed time.

3 Placing an order on the internet

If your order is for John Murray fresh meat, milk and fresh vegetables it might not be available till the next day or the following one depending on the time of order.
