  parish council but for large repairs or replacement, the family will be asked if they would like to make
  repairs or replace. If they are unable to make repairs/replace or cannot be located, Shere Parish
  Council reserves the right to remove the bench and replace with a standard bench if needed or allow
  a new memorial bench to be installed by another family.
