- 21.101 Finance Committee to <u>receive and approve minutes (Appendix 5)</u> and consider the following recommendations:
 - a) To add Councillors M Keeble and R Smith as signatories on all accounts
 - b) To enter into the RBS Rialtas three-year contract loyalty scheme
 - c) To move £10,000 from Unity Bank to Boom Credit Union, pending confirmation that the money held in Boom CU is instant access
 - d) To adopt of the draft budget 2022/23 (appendix 6) including the following:
 - Formally thank Shere Village Hall for their support with the Drop-In Centre
 - Formally ask the cinema to support the Drop-In with regards to the film bank cost and refreshments
 - Approach the Henry Smith fund for support in providing a hot meal to attendees once a month
 - Approach NHS SURREY HEARTLANDS CCG to enquire about funding for the Drop-In Centre and the link with social prescribing for residents in need.
 - e) The precept for 2022/23 be set at £162,028 (Appendix 7) Representing (on a Band D property) a weekly increase of 21p and a total yearly cost increase from £71.13 to £82.18 (depending on the final tax base). The committee concurred that costs of supplying services (important to the community and previously provided by the Borough or County Council) were continuingly increasing.
- 21.102 **General Purposes Committee Meeting –** <u>to receive minutes</u> and consider the following recommendations:
 - a) Swimming Pool Path, to raise the soil alongside the new path £520 exc. VAT funded from Parish Maintenance Earmark Reserve (Public Health Act 1987 s 164; Open Spaces Act 1906 ss 9&10). Works to be carried out in Spring 2022 after the works to the swimming pool changing rooms have taken place.
 - b) Four 84 litre metal bin inserts for the wooden bins along the stream in Shere, at £62.49 exc. VAT each, funded from general reserves via Highway's code (Litter Act 1983 ss 56)
 - c) Tillingbourne Silt Clearance, Gomshall (works to the area of stream maintained by Shere Parish Council) £2,600 exc. VAT funded from Parish Maintenance Earmark Reserve (Public Health Act 1936 s 260)
- 21.103 **Management and Strategy Working Group** <u>to receive minutes</u> and consider the following recommendations:
 - a) The following overarching objectives for all wards:
 - 1. To try to mitigate the adverse effects of increased traffic and visitor numbers throughout the parish on the community and environment by:
 - addressing health and safety concerns, such as maintaining access for emergency vehicles, pavement obstruction and traffic speed dangers
 - prioritising the physical and mental wellbeing of residents
 - actively look for additional sources of revenue to reduce the financial burden of visitors (to reduce the percentage of parish council precept spent on visitor amenities)
 - 2. To recognise and try to address the risks to the parish environment and residents arising from climate change and visitor activities by:
 - Lessening, where possible, the impact of adverse trends, such as flooding from heavy rainfall, trail erosion from overuse etc.
 - considering the environmental effect of every council decision
 - furthering and promoting national guidelines, to achieve change at local level
 - b) To Ratify the Shere Public Consultation for car park charging, pedestrianisation for part of The Square and further yellow lines at a cost of approximately £600 (Local Government Act 1972 s 142)
