Reffo commented on the unreasonable service experienced from Surrey Highways, relating to long standing highways issues in Peaslake.  It was AGREED for S. Robins to ask Clerks from neighbouring parishes for their views to assess if further action should be taken.  S. Robins is to send a list of outstanding requests to Surrey Highways and ask for an explanation as to why they have not been completed.  B. Andrews requested a site for a VAS in Holmbury, to be placed at the Abinger end of the village subject to agreement by the Surrey Highways Traffic Officer. S. Robins to request for this and add to the VAS rota.  S. Robins to check where the Shere Parish Council speedwatch equipment is.

23/GP39	New Bin for Swimming Pool Field – to consider quotes – It was AGREED to recommend to council to purchase one Double Iroko Hardwood Bin to include ground fixings and delivery, from Kingfisher Direct for £1,204.98 exc. VAT. To be funded from the Parish Maintenance fund - £622.48 and Guildford Borough Council grant aid - £582.50.
