A member of public attended to talk about issues with the residents / sport club overflow car park in Shere. The gate is frequently left open and non residents / non sport club users are parking in the overflow. Proper signage will go a long way to reduce illicit parking.

It was proposed by ClIr Keeble and all members agreed to move items 25/GP29 forward in the agenda to this point.

### 25/GP29 Consideration of a New Gate for the Overflow Car Park in Shere

To review the condition and security of the existing entrance to the overflow car park in Shere, and to consider the installation of a new gate to improve access control, safety, and appearance.

It was AGREED to arrange immediate repair to the gate to replace the rotten top rail / adjust the hinges and install new signage to ensure the gate is shut. It was noted that a new sign was already on order and it was resolved that additional signs to ensure the gate is shut on entry and exit will be required.

It was noted that a meeting with the landowner is being planned to discuss parking in the village as an overall topic.

It was noted that the agreement with Shere Surgery car park has finished and written confirmation that Shere Parish no longer have any maintenance obligations is required.
